SPACE IN EACH DIVISION IS LIMITED AND ENTRY FEE MUST BE RECEIVED TO BE CONSIDERED ENTERED. ROSTERS AND ENTRIES MAY BE EMAILED AS WELL.

Players must only be on one team. Players may play up a grade level but may not play down a grade level

All teams must have uniform shirts with visible numbers

There will be an adult spectator admission of \$3.00. Players, coaches and students under 17 free.

There will be concessions available at some of the gym locations.

SDHSAA basketball rules will be used along with the following exceptions:

- Three time outs per game, one time out for each overtime. Time outs DO NOT carry over to overtime
- Overtimes are 2 minutes
- All games will play two 18 minute halves, with a running clock. Clock will stop only the last two minutes of the game on referee whistles for all infractions
- Halftime is 5 minutes
- The games will be allowed to start early if both teams agree
- 3rd/4th grade — no pressing at any time during the game
- 5th/6th grade — may only press during last 2 minutes of the game
- 7th/8th grade — can press or play man-to-man or zone defense
- No press — when ahead by 10 points or more
- No Zone Defense — only man-to-man is allowed except for 7th & 8th grade
- Three point rule applies on courts where there is a line marked
- A running clock will NOT stop on whistles when a team is trailing by 15 points or more
- All technical fouls will result in two (2 points) awarded to the opposing team plus the ball out of bounds. Any player or coach receiving a second personal foul for unsportsmanlike conduct will be removed from the game
- Coaches and parents are responsible for players at all times off the court
- 28.5 (Girl's Basketball) will be used for all levels
- A team may be suspended from further play for unsportsmanlike conduct by its players, coaches, team managers, or fans. Officials will enforce a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY regarding foul or inappropriate language or behavior
- In round robin brackets for tournament placing, overall record will determine. Break ties with head-to-head scores. If there is a 3-way tie for first, use fewest points allowed for all games to determine standings
